**RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL OF A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW AN ELDER CARE RESIDENTIAL UNIT TO BE CONSTRUCTED ONSITE. THE PROPERTY CONTAINS SOME AREAS WITHIN THE FEMA MAPPED FLOODPLAIN AND SOME AREAS WITHIN THE SHORELAND OVERLAY DISTRICT OF THE BLUE EARTH RIVER. HOWEVER, THE REQUESTED LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS OUTSIDE OF BOTH THE FLOODPLAIN AND THE SHORELAND OVERLAY DISTRICT. THE PROPERTY IS ZONED CONSERVATION AND IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHERN HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 28, SOUTH BEND TOWNSHIP.

2. That any expansion or intensification of the proposed use be reviewed and approved by County staff prior to the commencement of the expansion or intensification.
3. The applicant shall commence the proposed use within one year from the date of approval by the County Board.

1. That all Level II Home Occupation activities shall be conducted entirely within the dwelling or accessory building and shall be carried on by the inhabitants thereof. Six (6) employees are allowed other than the inhabitants.
2. That the conditional use shall be clearly incidental and secondary to the use of the property for residential purposes.
3. That the Level II Home Occupation shall not exceed 5000 square feet.
4. That the property shall not be used as a junkyard, as defined in Chapter 24 of the Blue Earth County Code of Ordinances.
5. That the allowable signage shall be limited to a 32-square foot, non-illuminated sign. The sign shall be located on the property.

6. That there shall be no indication of offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat or glare at or beyond the property line.
7. That the operation of the home occupation shall begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and end no later than 5:00 p.m. Additional hours shall be reviewed by the Planning Commission and approved by the County Board of Commissioners.
8. Materials and equipment associated with the Level II Home Occupation shall be stored in an enclosed building or screened area.
9. All vehicles associated with the Level II Home Occupation shall be parked off-street and entirely upon the lot on which the home occupation is operated.
10. That the applicant shall obtain and maintain all permits as required by the state of Minnesota and shall maintain any and all records as required by the state.
11. That when hazardous wastes are generated, the applicant shall obtain an EPA ID number to enable the business to participate in the Very Small Quantity Generator program to dispose of hazardous waste or obtain a registration number if classified as a Minimal Quantity Generator.
12. That the property will need to be brought into septic compliance by October 21, 2019.

5. That all secondary fuel containment for the storage tanks and the loading area shall be installed and maintained as required by the State of Minnesota.

6. All spills required to be reported to the Minnesota State Duty Officer shall also be reported to the Blue Earth County Property and Environmental Resources Department.
7. The facility shall be operated in a way that limits the impacts on surrounding uses. This includes noise, dust, odors and lighting.

1. All other applicable licenses and permits shall be obtained from the appropriate agency and maintained in association with the operation of the winery.
2. Any proposed changes to a winery to add or modify food or beverage sales, or to amend other services and activities offered, shall be brought back before the planning commission and county board for review.
3. Outdoor live music shall be permitted during the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
4. The farm winery must comply with the provisions in the Blue Earth County Code of Ordinances section 24-310 parking and loading regulations.
5. The farm winery shall be located on a minimum parcel size of ten acres of which at least two and one-half acres shall be dedicated to the growing of fruit(s) used in the making of wine at the winery.
6. The retail sale of beer may only occur during normal operating hours of business and must be incidental to the primary operation of the winery.
7. The total gross receipts of the sale of non-wine related items including food, beverages other than wine, glassware, wine literature and accessories, shall not exceed 35 percent of the total retail sales of the winery.
8. The SSTS and all associated components shall be maintained in accordance with MPCA SSTS standards. The SSTS of a winery shall be separate from residential use associated with the property.
9. That prior to startup of the winery, the owners shall submit a change of access permit to the County Public Works Department to change the access classification from residential to commercial.
